Dear Rhine River Cruise Enthusiast:

Please accept our personal invitation to join us next summer on a Viking River Cruise in July **"Rhine River Getaway" Basel, Switzerland to Amsterdam, July 10 – 21, 2016.** Enclosed you will find Trip Registration Form, Itinerary, Cruise Highlights, Passenger Information Form, Ship Features and Ship Deck Plan. The price of this cruise/tour package ranges from \$6,795.00 - \$7,295.00 per person (based on double room occupancy) depending on the stateroom category selected. The price includes round trip bus transportation from Portland to Chicago O'Hare Airport, estimated round trip air to Basel Switzerland, returning from Amsterdam, round trip airport to boat transfers, 7-night River Cruise aboard Viking River Cruises Longship "Kvasir", (including 7 guided sightseeing tours while on the cruise, plus all meals and entertainment onboard ship), two night pre-cruise accommodations at Radisson Blu in Basel, Switzerland, guided walking tour through Historic Basel, dinner provided in Basel, one night post-cruise accommodations at Radisson Blu in Amsterdam, plus a full day sightseeing tour in Amsterdam.

If you have never been on a River Cruise, there is a world of difference between river cruising and sailing on an ocean-going vessel that carries 3,000 + passengers. This ship can accommodate only 190 passengers, so it will be a very intimate experience. You will get to know your fellow passengers and receive personalized service from onboard staff, and there is no waiting in long lines to embark, disembark, or for a meal. After boarding the ship, you'll unpack just once in your river-view stateroom, then relax and enjoy the professional services and amenities onboard the ship. And because the river offers smooth sailing, there is no motion sickness. On the river you can sit back, relax, and enjoy the incredible beauty of the countryside as you journey into the heart of Europe's greatest cities. ***You will enjoy breathtaking scenery that's constantly changing through panoramic windows in the restaurant and lounge and stunning 360 views from the sun deck.***

This ship can accommodate only 190 guests. All staterooms are sold on a first-come, first-serve basis. Viking Cruise Lines requires a deposit to be paid in order to assign a stateroom. There is a \$150 per person cancellation fee to cancel or change the name on any stateroom. Unfortunately, we do not have the luxury of holding staterooms (with non-refundable fees) to sell at a later date to our passengers on this cruise. If you are considering this cruise, we strongly urge you to make up your mind soon, as availability is limited on such a small ship. **In order to confirm your reservation, please complete and sign the enclosed Trip Registration Form along with the Medical Liability Waiver attachment and return to us along with a \$1,000 per person deposit (plus travel insurance premium if you choose to purchase it). Also complete the enclosed Passenger Information and return it to us along with a copy of the Photo Page in your Passport, as Viking will require this information to complete your Cruise Registration. We will hold your deposit until we receive deposits from 10 passengers (minimum passengers require for this cruise). Once we receive deposits from 10 passengers, we will assign your stateroom based on the category you have selected on your Trip Registration Form. The remaining balance for this tour will be due on or before December 4, 2015.** Please mark your calendar, as we do not send payment due notices.

We cannot confirm contracted group air fare for this tour more than eleven months prior to date of trip return. The package price quoted includes an estimated air price based on air departure from Chicago with group transportation from Portland to Chicago O'Hare Airport. If group air exceeds \$1,600 per person and if our departure gateway is different than Chicago, the package tour price will be adjusted accordingly. Total package price will also be adjusted if air rates are under \$1,600 and departure gateway is different than Chicago. We must have 10 passengers to guarantee the group cruise rates quoted. If the group falls below 10 passengers, this cruise/tour will not be escorted and package price will be revised based on individual air and cruise rates without transportation to the airport. We will not apply your deposit to confirm a stateroom until we receive deposits from at least 10 passengers.

We highly recommend you purchase travel insurance to protect your investment against loss of payments in the event of trip cancellation due to sickness, injury or death of yourself, your traveling companion or a family member. Benefits also cover trip interruption, travel delay, medical expenses (please be aware that Medicare does not provide coverage outside the U.S.), lost luggage and protection from financial default of travel suppliers. With the troubling economic times the world is experiencing, financial default of any business is very realistic today. We cannot foresee or control such actions, thus, we encourage you to purchase travel insurance to protect your investment. Please be aware that Medicare does not provide medical coverage outside the U.S. Unless you have supplemental insurance to cover you in a foreign country, you may be traveling without medical coverage. The medical expense coverage under our travel insurance plan will reimburse you for out-of-pocket medical expenses up to \$50,000 plus there is \$250,000 coverage for emergency evacuation & repatriation. If you purchase the plan within 21 days of making your initial trip deposit, pre-existing medical conditions are waived. We urge you to pay the premium when you make your initial trip deposit for these benefits to apply. Please read cancellation policy attached to the Trip Registration Form for more details. If you elect not to purchase the plan, kindly initial Trip Registration Form where indicated.

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO CARRY A VALID PASSPORT ON THIS TRIP!!! PLEASE SEND US A COPY OF THE PHOTO PAGE ON YOUR PASSPORT, AS IT CONTAINS INFORMATION REQUIRED TO COMPLETE YOUR CRUISE REGISTRATION.



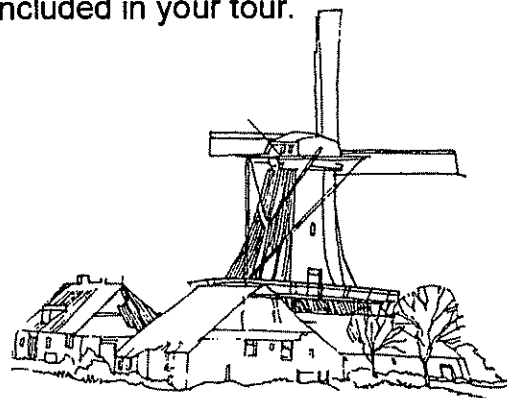
